

REDUCE & RE-USE

Habitat for Humanity Re-Store*

(*items accepted at the Lander Recycling Center,
Riverton Bale Center,
and the Habitat for Humanity Re-Store)

Household Appliances*

Furnaces/Fireplace inserts/pellet stoves, etc*

***Must be clean and in 100 percent working condition*

Cabinet/counter tops: Only complete cabinets with all doors and drawers

Doors/windows: In good condition, straight, free of holes & broken glass (aluminum windows and screens are NOT generally acceptable)

Electrical/lighting: Light fixtures, wires, breakers, breaker boxes, switch plates, switches and conduits (No non-grounded receptacles and used wiring)

Flooring material: Carpet in new or great condition, tile, hardwood, parquet, rugs, and ceramic tile. Only new linoleum.

Furniture: Must be in overall good condition and need no repair, free of rips, tears and stains. Mattresses, bedsprings and headboards NOT accepted

Hardware/tools: No rust

Household items: Blinds must be new and never used, mirrors free of chips and cracks

Lumber/siding/trim /plywood/roofing: Sheetrock, wafer board in quarter sheets or larger; lumber, siding, PVC, pipe, and copper must be four feet or longer. NO creosote, free of nails, screws, rot or other damage. Shingles must be in complete packages.

Plumbing/sinks/toilets: Must be clean and in usable condition; toilets must have tank top; all hardware must be complete.

Items not accepted:

Water heaters, florescent light bulbs, computers, monitors, printers or other electrical waste; soft goods such as clothing, bed sheets, bedspreads, curtains; children's toys; books, records, DVDs, VCR or audio tapes, kitchenware, dishes, pots, pans or cooking utensils.
