September 18, 2023

1. PRELIMINARY ITEMS:

a.-c. The regular meeting of the Fremont County Solid Waste Disposal District Board of Directors was held on the above date called to order by CHAIRMAN MOXLEY at 9:30 am. CHAIRMAN MOXLEY then led the Pledge of Allegiance and declared that there was a quorum of the Board with the following people in attendance:

RICK KLAPROTH made a motion to approve the consent agenda as presented. KYLE LARSON seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED**

e. Public Comment/Communication from the Floor

CHAIRMAN MOXLEY opened the floor to public comment. There was no public comment.

3. NEW BUSINESS:

- a. Scale Facility Projects Burns and McDonnell (Discussion and Formal Action)
 - i. Project Update (Lander and Dubois) <u>Cassidy Tieman</u> with Burns and McDonnell via zoom reviewed the current constructions projects and anticipated timelines.
 - <u>Cassidy Tieman</u> with Burns and McDonnell made a recommendation of payment to Alexander Construction for the Lander Scalehouse Site project, Pay Application #3, in the amount of \$158,409.54.

<u>VICE-CHAIR DOLCATER</u> made a motion to approve the Alexander Pay Application #3 for the Lander Scalehouse. <u>BOB</u> TOWNSEND seconded the motion. *MOTION CARRIED*.

b. Lander Transfer Station Project – Burns and McDonnell (Discussion and Formal Action)

- i. Project Update <u>Cassidy Tieman</u> with Burns and McDonnell reviewed the current project and anticipated timelines. A problem with concrete debris along the footer on the northwest corner was identified. The plan is to excavate and fill. There is potential for a change order.
- Alexander Construction <u>Cassidy Tieman</u> with Burns and McDonnell recommended payment to Alexander Construction for the Lander Transfer Station, Pay Application #4, in the amount of \$229,539.15.

<u>VICE-CHAIR DOLCATER</u> made a motion to approve the Alexander Construction Pay Application #3 for the Lander Scalehouse. <u>KYLE LARSON</u> seconded the motion. *MOTION CARRIED*.

c. Dubois Scalehouse Site Project – Burns and McDonnell (Discussion)

 Project Update (Lander and Dubois) <u>Cassidy Tieman</u> with Burns and McDonnell via zoom reviewed the current constructions projects and anticipated timelines. She noted that the project is ahead of schedule looking for the full transition into the new scale facility by September 28th or 29th.

<u>RICK KLAPROTH</u> made a motion to approve the forty-one day advertisement for final payment contingent upon <u>Matt Evans</u> with Burns and McDonnell's certifying as complete and authorizing. <u>VICE-CHAIR DOLCATER</u> seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED.**

d. Sand Draw Scalehouse Site Project – Burns and McDonnell (Discussion and Formal Action)

i. <u>Cassidy Tieman</u> with Burns and McDonnell recommended and requested approval to advertise the Sand Draw Scalehouse Site Project.

<u>VICE-CHAIR DOLCATER</u> made a motion to approve the advertisement of request for bids for the Sand Draw Scalehouse Site Project. <u>KYLE LARSON</u> seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED**.

e. WRITC Meeting Update - (Discussion)

i. The updated WRITC Contract was signed by all parties and went into effect September 1, 2023.

4. **NEW BUSINESS**

a. Compactor Bid Summary (Discussion and Formal Action)

i. Andy Frey with Trihydro reviewed the waste compactor bids with the Board. A single bid was received and submitted by Wyoming Machinery in the amount of \$591,715.

<u>KYLE LARSON</u> made a motion to award the waste compactor bid to Wyoming Machinery's bid for a new compacter in the amount of \$591,715 with the amendment of the District accepting the trade offer contingent on the new machine delivery prior to the timeline when the trade machine reaches 5,500 hours. Any reduction in trade value offering based on hours beyond 5,500 will be reviewed by the Board. <u>ROD HAPER</u> seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED**.

b. Scrap Metal Processing Bid Summary (Discussion and Formal Action)

i. Andy Frey with Trihydro reviewed the scrap metal processing bids with the Board. Two Bids were received: Pacific Steel at \$85 per ton, and Western Metals at \$132.69 per ton.

RICK KLAPROTH made a motion to award the bid to Western Metals Recycling at \$132. 69 per ton, contingent on providing proof of current Workers' Compensation coverage. KYLE LARSON seconded the motion. MOTION CARRIED.

c. Propane Bid Summary (Discussion and Formal Action)

i. <u>Camille Woody</u> reviewed the propane bids with the Board. Two bids were received: Pirate Propane at \$2.19 per gallon, and Ferrellgas at \$1.80 per gallon.

<u>BOB TOWNSEND</u> made a motion to award the bid to Ferrellgas at \$1.80 per gallon. <u>KYLE LARSON</u> seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED.**

d. Update County Commissioners on Progress (Discussion)

i. <u>Commissioner Jones</u> provided suggestions to the Board on different approaches to better inform the County Commissioners on District's progress.

Project Updates for October 16, 2023, Board Meeting

The following information is provided to update the Board of the Fremont County Solid Waste Disposal District (District) regarding the status of various projects that are being managed by Trihydro Corporation (Trihydro), and associated activities associated with the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality (WDEQ), Solid and Hazardous Waste Division (SHWD), Water Quality Division (WQD), and Air Quality Division (AQD). The information provided is generally limited to activity during the previous month.

Sand Draw, Shoshoni, Lander, and Dubois Landfills – 2023-2024 Environmental Activities and Monitoring (Task Order 10-035 / Trihydro Project FREMO-023-0001)

Activities associated with this work order during the previous month and anticipated in the near future include:

- Third quarter methane monitoring was conducted on September 17th.
- Semiannual groundwater monitoring and fourth quarter methane monitoring were conducted the week of October 9th. Data management, data validation, statistical analysis, and reporting will commence upon receipt of the data.

Technical Assistance (Task Order 10-036 / Trihydro Project FREMO-023-0007)

Technical assistance activities during the previous month are as follows:

- A monthly Board memo was prepared for the September 2023 District Board meeting.
- A monthly Project Status Report was prepared to accompany the August 2023 invoice.
- Trihydro submitted new revisions (reductions) on the site-by-site Environmental Monitoring Plan (EMP) modifications for Dubois and Shoshoni to reduce monitoring requirements for review by the WDEQ/SHWD. Revisions to the Lander and Sand Draw modifications are still underway.
- On October 6, 2023, WDEQ/SHWD approved the groundwater EMP modification for the Dubois Landfill. A summary of the new requirements follows.
 - o Groundwater monitoring has been reduced from semiannual to annual. Furthermore,

- groundwater sampling will only be required if there is water in a down-gradient well, which are typically dry or have insufficient water for sampling.
- o Going forward, field activities will include quarterly methane monitoring and, if no groundwater is present in down-gradient wells, only annual groundwater level gauging. This will reduce lab costs, equipment costs, and labor costs substantially.
- Reporting costs will also go down next year because only one report will be required, and there will be no groundwater quality data review or statistical analysis.
- Continued communication attempts with the Army National Guard (ANG) on borrow source authorization for the Lander Landfill. The ANG conducted a site visit in September 2023.

Operational Support Services (Task Order 10-037 / Trihydro Project FREMO-023-0008)

Support service activities during the previous month are as follows:

- Document Review and Development: special waste disposal request from Bull Lake Dam reconstruction, finalized scrap metal bid docs and discussion on Tribal scrap metal stockpiles, waste compactor bid award notice, draft FCSWDD annual report, draft correspondence to county commission, review and comment on capacity audits, and finalized propane bid award notices.
- Projects: construction meetings for the Dubois and Lander scale projects and the Lander transfer station project, reviewed and commented on tire shredder and coordinate surveying-freight-staff and equipment for tire shredding project.
- Regulatory: finalized notice of termination for Shoshoni Industrial Stormwater permit.
- Other: assisted the District with communication and coordination of waste compactor issues through Wyoming Machinery, and interview for director candidate.

Subject: Progress Report – October 2023

The following provides an update on work completed by Burns & McDonnell since the last Progress Report.

Lander Transfer Station Project

Since the last Board meeting, Alexander Construction (Alexander) has been completing excavation activities associated with the building foundations. The excavated material that is free of rock has been used as fill for a portion of the embankment on the scalehouse project.

On September 12, 2023, buried concrete was encountered as part of the footings excavation. The extents of the concrete were evaluated by Advanced Geotechnical Solutions out of Casper. The associated management of it warranted a change order item for Alexander. Hours and equipment associated with the activities were recorded by the project team and communicated with the District. The excavation and associated replacement of excavated materials was substantially complete the week of September 25, 2023.

Additionally, Alexander is currently prepping for foundation placement and will be working on this for the remainder of the construction season. Alexander is also evaluating placing utilities associated with the building this fall. This includes sanitary and septic lines, water lines and cistern, and the fire water tank. Alexander has observed buried concrete in the area where the utilities are to be placed. Burns & McDonnell and Alexander are currently evaluating the potential impact the concrete will have on the utility work.

Based on progress to date and projected future activities, Alexander still appears to be able to complete the project on time (i.e., by November 15, 2024).

Biweekly construction meetings continue. Agenda items of the meetings include safety, schedule, submittal/RFI log review, coordination items, and other business that may be affecting the project.

Lander Scalehouse Project

Since the last Board meeting, Alexander has completed site grading and scale foundation work associated with the new Lander Scalehouse. Additionally, Rocky Mountain Power has installed new electrical service to the scalehouse.

It appears at this time that Alexander will be challenged to complete the project by their contract required completion date of November 15, 2023. Burns & McDonnell is monitoring progress and

evaluating potential impacts of much of the work being completed in colder temperatures. The colder temperatures could have an impact on the schedule of the asphalt placement.

Biweekly construction meetings continue. Agenda items of the meetings include safety, schedule, submittal/RFI log review, coordination items, and other business that may be affecting the project.

Dubois Scalehouse Project

The foundation of the new scalehouse was completed in two steps since the last Board meeting. There was the base foundation and utility tie-ins that were set at the end of July. The final reinforced concrete slab foundation was poured on August 15, 2023 and the scalehouse was set on the foundation with a crane and tied in the week of August 21, 2023. Entrance sidewalks, ramps, catwalks, and gate have been completed. Electrical and internet service have been installed.

LCI appears to be on schedule to complete the project in October. They are contractually required to complete it by November 15, 2023.

Biweekly construction meetings continue. Agenda items of the meetings include safety, schedule, submittal/RFI log review, coordination items, and other business that may be affecting the project.

Sand Draw Scalehouse Project

Rebidding of the Sand Draw scalehouse project began in October 2023. The first advertisement occured October 4, 2023. Prior to bidding the following items were modified for the project: power supply, and location, of a new electrically operated entrance gate, and reducing the extents of the asphalt paving. The updated project and cost estimate were brought before the Board at the September Board meeting.

Capacity Audits

Surveys for the 2023 capacity audits were completed in the first week of July 2023. Capacity audit reports are being prepared. It is anticipated that Burns & McDonnell will present the capacity audit reports to the Board at the October 2023 Board meeting.

Technical Engineering Assistance

Burns & McDonnell completed our monthly progress report, invoice and overall project management related to the administration of the project as part of this task.

Capital Improvement Plan Modeling

Burns & McDonnell presented the results of the updated model to the Board at the June Board

meeting. The model will be updated next spring as part of the District's budget process.

On-call Surveying

Surveying associated with the three construction projects was completed since the last Board meeting. No other surveying activities were completed.
