Minutes of Regular Board Meeting

March 16, 2026

1. PRELIMINARY ITEMS:

a.-c. The regular meeting of the Fremont County Solid Waste Disposal District Board of Directors was held on the above date called to order by CHAIRMAN MOXLEY at 9:30 am. 3. BUSINESS ITEMS:

a. **Community-Minded Illegal Waste Cleanup Program (*Discussion*)**

Business Manager Woody reported that following the February meeting, the draft document was revised as per comments offered and distributed to the Board via email.

Discussion: (1.) Landowner signatures necessary, may be a challenge on public land. (2.) Review and selection process. (3.) An \$8,000 allocation for this program would allow for up to 100 tons. (4.) Spring cleaning versus summer/fall.

b. Bid Review – Aluminum Bale Sales (*Discussion and Formal Action*)

Business Manager Woody presented to the Board the bids received for the Aluminum Bale sales request for bids, communicating that the District publicly advertised the request. One bid was received, submitted by Hopper Metals with an offering of \$0.675 per pound.

Discussion: (1.) At the last bid offering the high bid was \$0.475. (2.) At the time of the bid offering there was 71 bales onsite at the Riverton Transfer Station.

VICE-CHAIRMAN DOLCATER made a motion to accept the Hoppers Metal bid of \$0.675 per pound for the onsite baled aluminum bales. KYLE LARSON seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED**

4. NEW BUSINESS:

a. **Lander Projects – Warranty Work.** Business Manager Woody summarized the completed work that should have been addressed by the contractor, including:

- Phoenix Electrical: electrical installations and repairs,
- LCI: concrete repairs, repairs to the utility hatch, repairs to both cisterns, and breakroom incomplete finish work.
- Overhead Door: repaired the two south-facing man doors.
- WYO Glass: continues to work on replacement of the windows – this includes the windows at the Sand Draw and Dubois sites.
- Burns and McDonnell: continues to review the concrete floor failure and remedy.

The costs incurred to date are approximately \$45,000, which does not include the window replacements, the Burns and McDonnell review costs, or the pending concrete floor repairs.
